
2023.24 ACA President's Report




Communication

A new initiative this season was the weekly member-only e-newsletter so thanks to Karen Rickerby for doing this.


Meanwhile we have seen good growth in the reach of our bi-monthly ACA in Action



Also an increase in our ACA website sessions, in particular showing the positive impact of the ACA Race Nights




Our **Instagram** reach has grown


Events

ACA TRACK & FIELD 2023-2024

It was great to be back on familiar ground at the Mt Smart Stadium #2 track for our 2023-24 summer Track & Field Club Nights, with full access to the facilities for our athletes to train and compete.

Attendance at Club Night competitions was quite low amongst the senior athletes, but our numbers were boosted by the schools who have been encouraged to take part in our Club Nights, and also by those athletes who are coached or who purely train at the track on Wednesday evenings. We also again hosted host young athletes from the Central HUB (Eastern, Ellerslie, Hillsborough, Pt. Chevalier and Roskill South junior Clubs) who have been training and sometimes competing on Wednesday Club nights.

ACA ran 15 Wednesday Club Nights over the course of the season, plus four extremely successful ACA Race Night Events, well-attended by ACA athletes and athletes from other Clubs and the regions. This has had a healthy flow-on effect to our regular Club Nights, with athletes requesting invitational events on other Club Nights to enable them to seek qualifying times amongst high-quality fields of local and out-of-town athletes.

In the 2023-24 Athletics Auckland Track and Field inter-club competition, the **McKinnon Shield**, ACA athletes performed well over the season. As a result ACA Club earned 100 points and finished 3rd = after the 8 rounds of competition.

ACA athletes also had some outstanding performances at the **2024 Auckland T&F Championships**, the majority of which were held in February. The **39** ACA athletes brought home 27 individual Gold medals, 19 Silvers and 9 Bronze medals. Outstanding performances at the Championships were **Charlotte Goldsmith** with Gold in the W20 Long Jump and W20 Triple Jump, and Silver in the W20 100m. **Ethan Phillips** was a triple Gold winner in the SM 100m, SM Shot Put and SM Discus. **Emilia Goldsmith** won double Gold in the W18 100m and 200m. **Benaiah Su** won gold in the M18 Shot Put, Silver in the M18 High Jump, and Triple Jump and Bronze in the M18 Discus. In the Masters Divisions, **Warren Ginige** and **Nivart Warnakulasooriya** shone out in their respective grades. There were numerous other multi-award winners.

At the **2024 NZ Championships** in Wellington in March, **36** ACA athletes competed, winning 17 individual medals: 7 Gold, 6 Silver and 4 Bronze, with four ACA runners also returning with Gold relay medals, and four athletes with Bronze relay medals.
